Note:- Domestic Consumer customers are those buying to use product themselves at home, as opposed to those who are buying for or on behalf of a business or other commercial organisation.

WE SHOULD ALL RECYCLE WASTE ELECTRICAL GOODS

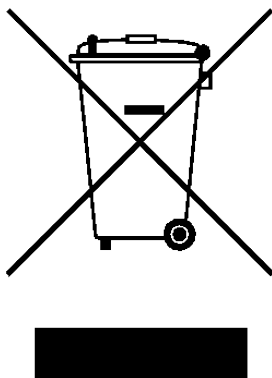
Each year in the UK we throw away over 1 million tonnes of electrical and electronic waste. This is the equivalent of over 750,000 family cars!!

Three quarters of waste electrical goods end up in landfill, where toxins and other pollutants can cause soil and water contamination. This can have a very harmful effect on natural habitat, wildlife and also human health.

Many of the electrical items that are thrown away can be recycled or repaired. Recycling items helps to save natural resources and also helps reduce the environmental risks of sending items to landfill.

To minimise our impact on this earth and to help protect the environment, the United Kingdom has introduced the Waste Electrical and Electronic regulations. It is important that we are all aware of these regulations and the consequences of our actions and how we can all make a difference.

The crossed out wheelie bin symbol



Electrical and Electronic equipment that was made after August 13th 2005 should display this symbol on the product. This symbol means that the product must either be sent to be repaired and reused or sent for treatment and recycling through an approved disposal system.

To ensure that we all meet the requirements of this legislation, we have joined the national Distributor take back scheme and are registered under ID 7736. As a member of this scheme, we have provided funds that allow all consumers to take your waste electrical and electronic equipment to your nearest civic amenity site (council tip) where facilities are in place for you to deposit your items safely and where you can be assured that they will be collected and recycled in accordance with these regulations.
